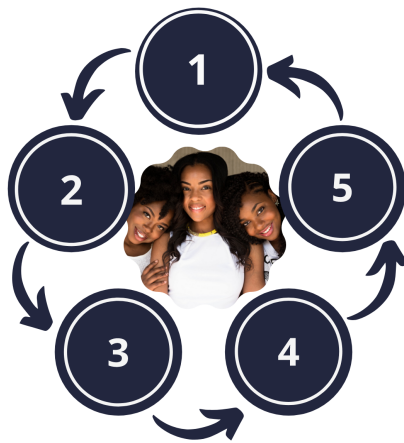


SVC AT A GLANCE

The Silent Victims of Crime are the 3 million children who are paying the price for a crime their parent(s) committed

Mission: Assist children of inmates by enhancing their ability to improve their economic, educational and personal stability while addressing behavioral, social and mental issues. By helping these at-risk children to deal with life challenges in a positive, proactive manner empowers them to make wise choices and contribute positively to society.

Vision: To break the intergenerational cycle of incarceration.



The "5 Circles of Support" Methodology, created by our founder in 1996, is based on a collaboration between families and communities who share a common goal.

1. Youth Empowerment Programs
2. Parent Programs
3. Caregiver Support
4. Community Collaboration
5. Mentoring & Peer Support

SOME OF OUR PROGRAMS:

LEADERSHIP PROGRAM: We bring together children and young adults to act as a team during monthly excursions. Leadership and entrepreneurial skills are developed so they can ultimately become positive role models and leaders in their community

CAMPS: Our South Carolina camps started in 2002. We provide educational focus, and a sense of social responsibility, in partnership with the Call Me MISTER program at Clemson University.

CARE COURT: Court-Assisted Re-Entry (CARE). We assist returning citizens with a successful re-entry into the community by creating a stable, constructive, and joyful interaction with their children and family.

INCARCERATED "PARENT" VISITATION: Maintains the connection between the child and the incarcerated parent by coordinating visits and a summer camp to correctional facilities in South Carolina and Florida.

CAREGIVER SUPPORT: Coordination of wrap-around services, including mental health assistance, morale building and conflict resolution
